### **Behaviour Policy for Kingfishers**



#### **Step One**

Make eye contact and use normal tactics to distract and settle the child e.g change of pace, move nearer to the child, target questions or praise good behaviour in the room.

## **Step Two**

Remove or redirect the child.

### **Step Three**

Child is given a time-out which is appropriate to their age and the nature of their behaviour.

### **Step Four**

Parents to be informed of their child's behaviour should it continue.

# **Step Five**

Play Leader will contact parents immediately to collect their child.

# **Step Six**

If behaviour continues, discussions will be held with the Head Teacher and may lead to a reduction in sessions, temporary or permanent exclusion from Kingfishers.

### Children can go straight to Step Six if:

- their behaviour is violent
- they use offensive language or
- they continually refuse to co-operate with adult concerned.

Remember to reward and praise especially whilst dealing with unsettled behaviour at Kingfishers.
