





# Year Two Term Five Newsletter

We hope that you all had a wonderful Easter. We have many exciting things happening. SATS assessments will take place during the last two weeks of the term.

<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p><b>Fractions, Time, Capacity and Temperature.</b></p> <p>The children will learn how to recognise fractions of shapes, work out fractions of amounts and compare fractions. Towards the end of the term the work will cover telling the time in 5 minute intervals. They will continue to recite their two, five and ten times tables, plus revise different methods of addition and subtraction of two digit numbers. Mastery Maths sessions will continue daily. Quick Maths continues on a Friday.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p><b>Journey story - Billy the Brave Knight.</b> The children will revise using conjunctions and start sentences in different ways.</p> <p><b>Instruction Writing</b> - writing a report about how to be a scientist and look after chick eggs and chicks!</p> <p><b>Spellings and Handwriting</b> - continuing to learn all of the Little Wandles tricky words, plus making sure that the ascenders and descenders are the correct size in our writing.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p>  <p>life cycle</p>	<p><b>Animals including Humans - Life Cycles</b></p> <p>Key vocabulary is: adult, young offspring, offspring, live young, reproduce, life cycle and develop. We are having a delivery from Living Eggs on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> May. We will have our own chicken eggs to hatch and baby chicks to look after for just under two weeks.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> 	<p><b>Pus, Warts and Smallpox - Edward Jenner</b></p> <p>Key vocabulary is: smallpox, vaccination, Edward Jenner, cowpox, vaccine, virus and infection.</p> <p>The children will learn about a famous local doctor who made a significant impact on the lives of people in Britain. Hopefully, we will visit his home in Berkeley.</p>
<p><b>Games</b></p>	<p><b>Tuesday</b> - Outdoor - multi skills - target games  <b>Thursday</b> - Indoor - gymnastics- landscapes</p>
<p><b>Well-Being</b></p>	<p><b>Being My Best</b></p>
<p><b>Music</b></p>	<p>Whole class music lessons starting on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> April</p>
<p><b>Religious Studies</b></p>	<p>We are looking at the 'good news' that Christians say Jesus brings.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p>	<p>We are learning about landscapes and drawing our own.</p>
<p><b>SATS</b></p>	<p>This work is carried out as part of the normal class lessons and is not under test conditions.</p>
