


Year Two Term Six Newsletter

We hope that you all had a wonderful half term enjoying the sunshine and rest. We have more exciting things planned.

<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Time, Statistics, Position and Direction The children will finish learning about how to tell the time in 5 minute intervals on an analogue clock. They will make and interpret tally charts, tables, block graphs and pictograms. They will be able to describe the position of an object and also movement using clockwise and anti-clockwise. Also they will continue to recite their two, five and ten times tables, plus revise addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Mastery Maths sessions will continue daily. Quick Maths continues on a Friday.</p>
<p>English</p> 	<p>Problem solving story - The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. The children will revise using conjunctions and start sentences in different ways.</p> <p>List Poetry - poems about the summer.</p> <p>Persuasive writing - writing about a new toy and why you should visit Portishead. The children will use rhetorical questions and revise the use of explanation marks.</p> <p>Spellings and Handwriting - continuing to learn all of the Little Wandles tricky words, plus making sure that the ascenders and descenders are the correct size and our handwriting is the neatest that it can be.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>Plants Key vocabulary is: sunlight, water, temperature, nutrition, bulbs, seedlings and germination. The class will grow plants from seeds and investigate how to keep a plant healthy.</p>
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>How is a coastal town different to King's Stanley?</p> <p>Key vocabulary is: coast, pier, beach, promenade, tourist, seaside, climate</p> <p>The children will learn about the human and physical features of the coastline, compare Portishead to King's Stanley and learn about how the RNLI keeps people safe near the coast.</p>
<p>Games</p>	<p>Tuesday - Outdoor - Animal Olympics and practising for sports day</p> <p>Thursday - Indoor - dance - Plants theme</p>
<p>Well-Being</p>	<p>Growing and Changing</p>
<p>Music</p>	<p>Whole class music lessons for another five weeks.</p>
<p>Religious Studies</p>	<p>What makes some places sacred to believers?</p>
<p>Computing</p>	<p>Use the multi-media app, Book Creator to make a photo book.</p>
<p>Design Technology</p>	<p>Perfect Pizzas</p>
<p>Countryside Skills</p>	<p>Wednesday 7th, 14th and 21st June, plus Thursday 8th and 15th June.</p>
