

# Wild Weather

## English:

First we will look at poetry and think about the images created for the reader. We will look at different Literary devices to create the images: onomatopoeia, metaphors and personification. We will look at the persuasive text, 'Should homework be banned in Primary School?'

## Games (outdoors) Thursday

We will be swimming at Stratford Park Leisure Centre this term on a Monday.

## PE (indoors) Tuesday

We will think about how we can move and balance using different parts of our body to create a gymnastic sequence as an individual, in pairs and in a group.

## Music

We will looking at a unit all about using tuned and body percussion based on the Rainforest. We will be thinking a bout the structure of a piece of music, recognise when there is one or two layers in a piece of music. We will have two different melodies playing together and two contrasting rthymns.

## Science:

In Science we will be learning all about the 'States of Matter'. We will be looking at solids, liquids and gases and how we can define the properties of these. We will be investigating how different solids melt according to the different heat applied.

## RE:

We will be thinking about Salvation and 'Why Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday.'  
We will be looking at a number of Bible stories that talk about Holy Week, Jesus' death and resurrection. We will be finding out and discussing what that means for Christians

## Maths:

In our maths this term we will be learning all about fractions. We will be finding fractions of quantities and moving from working with unit and simple fractions to using mixed number and improper fractions. We will move onto look at decimals and see the link between fractions and decimals.

## Geography

In geography we will be finding out the difference between weather and climate. We will be learning about climate zones around the world and the weather that each zone experiences. We will be finding out about biomes. We will use this knowledge to write a persuasive argument about going on holiday abroad.

## PSCHE:

In our PSCHE lessons we will be thinking about our rights and our responsibilities. We will be exploring what this means and then thinking about this relates to us in school.
