

English:

Our first text this term is a diary extract based on Wilbur the pig from Charlotte's Web.

Our non-fiction text is a discussion text "Should children wear school uniform?"

We will look at how to present both sides of an argument. As part of this we will be holding a debate.

Science:

Our science is, 'Animals including humans'. We will look at animals on the food chain thinking about consumers, predators and prey. We will be continuing to carry out experiments, predict and collect results.

Games: (Thursday - outdoors)

We will be doing netball this term. We will be looking at a range of passes - shoulder, bounce and chest. We will be thinking about attacking and defending. We will learn about the different positions in Netball and we will play inter-house matches against each other.

RE:

Our Wellbeing focus this term will be about growing and changing. We will look at how we have grown and how our bodies are changing, including menstruation.
