The key skills we want pupils to use during this topic:

I can edit and photo with simple tools

I can use a paint/drawing app to create a digital image

I can begin to cut out an image to layer on another image.

Key vocabulary

Edit

prepare material for publication by correcting, or changing it

Digital image

A digital image is a picture that is stored on a computer. It has been digitised, which means it has been changed into a sequence of numbers that computers can understand.

Crop/ cut

Cut is a command that allows you to "**cut out**" a selection of text or other data and save it to the clipboard.

Learning Steps

Key Knowledge (answers)

I can take photos using the ipads and save them.

Children to find interesting objects to photograph using the iPads.

Opening the camera, finding an object, focusing the iPad in order to take a photograph of an object.

I can edit a photo with simple tools

Use the cropping tool to cut crop down a photo

I can edit a photograph using different filters

Use the filter tool to edit a photograph

I can air drop a photograph to the class iPad.

Show the children how to airdrop photographs to a class iPad.

Final outcome:

TBAT take a photograph of an object, crop it, add a filter and airdrop it.
