What is our school day like?	Learn lots of subjects, eat lunch, play with our friends, We mainly walk/ car to shool
Where is Kavuka?	Kavuka is an area of Kenya. We have raised lots of money to help them have a lovely school. In Kavuka life is different
What is school like in Kavuka?	Go home for lunch at lunchtime, walk to school, lots more children in a class. (about 60). Their classrooms have much less in them. They sing the national anthem everyday. When they go home most children have to do chores.
