Elijah for being a wonderful swimmer and showing perseverance in the swimming race.

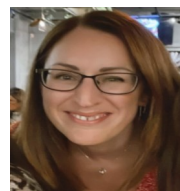
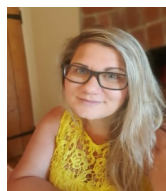
