Learning Step	Planned Activities (Key Knowledge)
Create collage using natural resources	Look at images of range of artwork created by using nature. Discuss the shapes, textures etc. Children to explore natural resources outside (provided by an adult) and make a piece of art with them. They can stick them down on paper or do it in a tray. Take photos.
Create art using natural resources that they find.	Remind them of previous lesson.  Go outside and work in groups or individually to collect natural resources and create art with them  Look at each other's art and review them together
How to 'dry out' natural resources and use them to create art.	Read or watch extract from Drawn from Nature book. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WllvqRbzZsE  Collect flowers, leaves etc from outside and press them in books.  Next lesson model how to make art inspired by the book
Child Initiated Activities  Children to be given time to reflect and review their art work with their peers and adults.	'Creation Station' accessible to children through out the day— paint, paper, chalk, glue, scissors, pens, pencils, hole punch, cellotape etc  Flowers and leaves to enhance provision—collage, printing etc  Natural resources around classroom. E.g. pine cones, wood circles etc
