### **Parent Pay Lunch Changes**

We're excited to announce a new and improved way of ordering school lunches, launching after half term! This change will make the process smoother and more efficient, help our caterers order according to actual demand, minimise food waste, and reduce our paper trail.

From now on, parents will be responsible for placing their child's meal orders directly through ParentPay, one week in advance. The full menu will be available on ParentPay, allowing you to view all meal options and select your child's preferred choices easily.

### **Key Information**

- In the first week back after half term, meal orders for the week beginning Monday 17th November must be placed by 8am on Monday 10th November.
- This system will continue on a weekly basis, with orders always due a week in advance.
- Please ensure that your ParentPay account has sufficient funds before placing an order as the system will no longer allow accounts to go into debt.
- Children eligible for free school meals will also use this ordering system. ParentPay recognises this entitlement, so no additional steps are required.

ParentPay will activate the new ordering system after half term, so please wait until then before attempting to log in and order. Once the system is live, you'll be able to follow the simple instructions below. We appreciate your support in helping us make this positive change.

**Log in:** Go to <u>www.parentpay.com</u> and log in with your username and password.

- 1. **Navigate to meal bookings:** Click on the "Make meal bookings" or "Book meals and places" button on the homepage.
- 2. Access the menu: Select "Make or view bookings" to open the meal menu for your child.
- 3. **Select meals:** Click on the daily menu to choose your child's meals for the desired days. You can pre-book meals up to 10 weeks in advance.
- 4. **Confirm selections:** Once you have made your choices, click "Confirm booking".
- 5. **Complete payment:** You will be taken to the payment screen. You will need to have the full amount of funds in your account, you can no longer go into debt.

**Finalize the order:** Review the order summary and complete the checkout process to finalize your payment.
