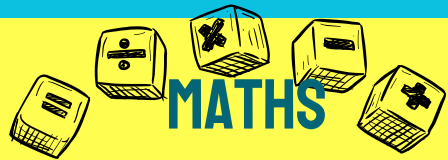


EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

We have dedicated art and design areas in the classroom. Children will be encouraged to start to think about observational drawing and drawing things around them. We will be practicing our skills on our school trip! In DT we will be making our own class flag to fly on the King's Castle!



MATHS

We have a Maths area in the classroom, where the children are able to explore mathematical concepts such as pattern, capacity and shape. Adults around the room extend their knowledge and understanding through play. In our Maths lessons, we will be thinking about numbers beyond 10 and we will continue to learn our number bonds within 5 and practice subitizing.

LITERACY

We are continuing Phase 4 Phonics. We will practice the GPCs we have learnt and also look at chunking and consonant blends. We will be heavily focusing on reading with automaticity. We will continue with Reading Practice Groups 3 times per week. In Drawing Club we continue to explore exciting stories and tales. Each week we will be challenging ourselves with new vocabulary and trying hard to use them in our phrases and sentences.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

We will continue to support the children in their relationships, we'll start to look at transition and what might be different in Y1.

We will also be learning about our the Pterosaur story and keeping our bodies private and also about growing and changing.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Our overall theme this term is 'Is everyone the same as King's Stanley?'. We will be looking at Kavuka and how it is different to King's Stanley and also spotting some human and physical features on our teddy bear's picnic.

As ever, the enhanced provision in the classroom means that the children can explore these concepts in their play and in 'Play Projects' with adults.

In RE we will look at what places are special and why they are special to different people. This includes ourselves, Christians and Muslims.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This term, we will continue to work on our fine and gross motor skills. We have lots of toys and equipment in the classroom that the children have access to, to help with this but we will also:

- continue with outdoor learning
- Develop our core strength using balance, apparatus and exercise through play.
- Writing daily, mastering scissors and our pencil grips ready for Year One
