



Mathematics

We will continue to count, recognise and write numbers to 10.

We will be looking at positional language, under, on behind etc.

We will also be thinking about weight and using scales to see which is heavier/lighter.

Literacy, Communication and Language

We will continue with our daily phonics sessions where we will be practising our letter sounds and blending them together to make simple words.

Our main text for this term will be The Little Red Hen. We will get to know this story well by re-telling it, acting it out and creating our own sandwiches. We will also continue to have many opportunities to talk, discuss and listen to other's opinions.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

We will think about the changes that happen during Autumn.

Which animals hibernate, what this means and how animals keep warm during the colder months.

Festivals celebrated during Autumn, leading into Christmas and the Nativity Story

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to take part in circle time games and activities and be encouraged to discuss feelings and thoughts. All the children will be encouraged to work together, look after one another and think about what makes a good friend.

Physical Development

As well as continuing to have physical play outside on a daily basis the children will continue to have gymnastics on a Weds morning where they will be looking at different types of jumps, how to land safely, balancing, using the equipment and putting together a routine that uses all these skills.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will continue to be able to access a variety of creative activities: painting, colouring, playdoh, cutting and sticking, role-play, exploring musical instruments and taking part in the Nativity play and Advent week.
