# **English**

As always we will be using the talk for writing method to support our writing.

### **Fiction**

We will be using The Snail and the Whale as our primary text for learning this term. We will write a journey story using different animals and link this to our geography about hot and cold regions of the world. Non-fiction text

We will write a non-chronological report based on an animal. We will need to conduct research, using the computers, to find out information about the animals. We will then put this together using the headings: appearance, diet and habitat.

### **Phonics**

We will continue to work on phase 5 phonics. The children's spellings are closely linked to the sounds they are learning at school.

# Geography

This term, we will be linking our learning to our English text 'The snail and the whale'. The animals travel around the world.

We will be locating hot and cold areas in the world in relation to the Equator. We will be thinking about the clothes that people need to wear in different countries.

We will compare our village with a village in India. We will start by looking at the physical landscape and we will discuss their buildings and lifestyles.

#### Maths

We will continue to develop a sense of number in the wider world. We will investigate how we use number in our daily lives.

Our focus this term will be on:

- Identifying 2D and 3D shapes
- Sorting 2D and 3D shapes
- Making patterns

## Place value with numbers to 20

- counting, comparing, ordering and looking for patterns
- Recognising numbers visually and writing the numbers in words

We will continue to practise our non-negotiables during fluent in 5 everyday.

## PE / Dance

We will have PE on **Wednesdays** and **Thursdays**, we will have our games lessons outside unless it is raining heavily, so please bring in jogging bottoms and sweatshirts. In games outside we will be looking at developing our throwing and catching skills in mini competitive games against each other.

Indoors, we will begin to use the apparatus to look at travel and balance linking this to our Science, we will be investigating how the different animals move and travel.





	Art We are going to create artwork inspired by Mondrian or the corridor display. This will link closely with our class work where we will be looking at the primary colours and colour mixing to make different colours. We will look at hot and cold colours and this will link to our Geography and Science. When completing the final piece, we will use colour washing to provide a background for our chosen animals. We will draw and create a silhouette of the animal to finish of our artwork.	Science In science we will be finding out all about animals and the groups they belong to. We will find out about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We will be able to explain why the animals belong in a specific group and suggest other animals that may belong in a specific group from our previous knowledge.
