Science	Rocks, Soils and Fossils Looking at different types of rocks - natural/manmade. Grouping rocks on basis of physical characteristics/properties. Testing rocks in different ways. Describing how fossils and soils are formed. Testing the permeability of soils.	
History	Stone Age The children will be looking at the changes within the Stone Age from Old Stone Age to new Stone Age. They will be focusing on what life was like for the people and how their way of life changed. They will have the opportunity to experience Stone Age life during their Countryside Skills sessions. Please arrive in the clothes for Countryside Skills on the day of your session.

Games	Rugby on a Monday afternoon with James Jefferies. Gymnastics on a Tuesday starting 5 th October.	
Music	Singing a variety of songs about the Stone Age.	
Religious Studies	What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?	
ICT	Learning how to use the features of WORD for word processing.	
CPSHE	New Beginnings, Friendship and Hope.
