

School Uniform

All pupils are encouraged to wear school uniform. The children are expected to attend school tidily and “seasonably” dressed.

The school uniform is:

- Grey skirt / trousers
- White or grey blouse / shirt / polo shirt
- Maroon jumper or cardigan
- In the summer the girls may wear pink gingham dresses or a gingham skirt and T-shirt / blouse.
- Sensible footwear should be worn—black or brown shoes, or sandals in the summer. No trainers or inappropriate sandals.
- Maroon sweatshirts and cardigans printed with the school motif, fleeces and hoodies for games may be purchased from Batemans, Stroud. T-shirts, polo shirts and shorts are also available, as are the school book bags. When children join us in Reception they are given a book bag.

P.E.

- A white T-shirt, navy shorts and daps are required for P.E.
Covid Update October 2020. Instead of keeping PE kit in school, all children are asked to wear their PE kit into school on the day they have PE to avoid bringing unnecessary items into school.

Football

- A separate kit is required for football which must be taken home after every session. Class teachers will tell pupils when football kit is required.
Covid Update October 2020. Not applicable currently.

Outdoor Learning

- **Covid Update October 2020** All children to bring in a spare pair of wellies or shoes to be kept at school as they are having more outside activities.
- Countryside Skills. All children take a turn in having Countryside Skills sessions. When it is their turn they need to bring in old clothes to wear. School provides waterproofs.
Covid Update October 2020. When it is their turn to do Countryside Skills children should come to school dressed in their Countryside Skills clothes.
- We would prefer that children do not bring any personal possessions, valuables or jewellery in to school. If for some reason it is unavoidable then please could you ensure that your child hands these in to their class teacher in the morning before registration.

Second Hand Uniform

- The PTFA run a second hand uniform ‘shop’ with a range of donated items – mostly jumpers, trousers and skirts but occasionally other items.
